Bridging Humanities and Social Sciences*.

The conference promotes the maintenance of a continuous dialogue between social and humanistic research areas and invites participants to discuss various modes in which the humanities and the social sciences can be integrated. In this way, their research could build bridges across languages and cultures as well as across different modes of communication in society. This concern aligns with contemporary directions in conducting inter- and trans-disciplinary research for the investigation of complex social themes and is based on the belief that the examination of topics from perspectives belonging to more study fields can lead to a better understanding of the subject and is conducive to more complex analyses. For example, studying the role and impact of technology on social life can be done with the assistance of combined approaches offered by socio-cultural studies, education, communication, linguistics, philosophy as well as from anthropological perspectives.

- Language teaching
- Translation studies
- Cultural studies, cultural anthropology
