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

From large to small: two hands-on projects to incorporate digital literacy in education –
Assoc. Lecturer PhD **Mariazell Eugènia BOSCH FÀBREGAS**, University of Lleida, Spain

Since digital literacy has become an educational necessity, this activity presents two projects to train digital literates while boosting critical thinking and raising awareness on gender, inclusion and accessibility in audiovisual and literary translation. The keynote talk will first provide an overview on the Erasmus+ AVTIA project in which University of Lleida participates with other six partners in the design of online training packages for lecturers (to consolidate required knowledge and skills, and to guide students or novice translators to offer quality audiovisual translation for inclusion services) and students (to develop essential skills in the field of audiovisual translation – AVT – and subtitling for in-class or autonomous learning). It further overviews an activity conducted in the Literary Translation subject at the same university in which Generative Artificial Intelligence (Gen-AI) is introduced to translate literary texts with gender issues, such as gender wordplay and unspecificity. This section deals with several aspects, such as: the students' human translations and a comparison to Gen-AI translations, human and Gen-AI translation differences, Gen-AI possibilities and limitations, (im)precisions, bias and "creativity" in the translation of gender aspects, also stressing the need of incorporating Gen-AI in the literary translation class, specially to boost the students' critical thinking, confidence and gender awareness.

Bio: **Mariazell Eugènia Bosch Fàbregas** holds a PhD in Translation, Gender and Cultural Studies. She is an associate lecturer at the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures (University of Lleida), where she teaches translation. She is a member of the research group TRACTE (Translation, Communication and Territory, UVic-UCC) and member of the Erasmus+ project AVTIA (Audiovisual Translation for Inclusion and Accessibility).

***Scientific Research and Creativity/Innovation: A Personal Perspective* – Assist. Prof. PhD Ivaylo GORCHEV, Konstantin Preslavsky University of Shumen, Bulgaria**

The session introduces the tension between expectations regarding linking previous research and new research, on the one hand, and personal contribution and innovation, on the other, and then elaborates on the reasoning behind specific creative endeavours on the part of the plenary speaker, which include the implementation of an original framework for assessment of media objectivity, adding to a framework of analysis for discourse representation in media

texts by Norman Fairclough and suggesting a slight refinement of a framework on the analysis of media representation of social actors by Theo van Leeuwen.

Bio: Ivaylo Gorchev is an Assistant Professor at the Department of English Studies at Konstantin Preslavsky University of Shumen, Bulgaria. He obtained a Bachelor's degree, with a major in "English Philology", in 2001, an MA degree in "English Philology–English Studies and Mass Communications" in 2018 and he defended his PhD in May 2024. His main research interest is in media discourse research and cognitive linguistics.
